### Installing

Download the 'Mail Disclaimers 1.0' installation file 'setup.exe' and run on the Microsoft Exchange Hub Transport Server. An MSI is available from support by contacting

[support@exclaimer.com](mailto:support@exclaimer.com).

### Uninstalling

Uninstall can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' or MSI for the currently installed version of 'Mail Disclaimers 1.0' or via 'Add/Remove Programs' in Windows Server 2003 or 'Programs and Features' in Windows Server 2008.

The configuration files are located in the following folder and will not be removed as part of the uninstall process:

The uninstall process will not lose any of your configuration or settings. However as a backup precaution you may wish to export your configuration.

## Export Steps

1. Open the Exclaimer Console.
2. Select the 'Exclaimer' node.
3. Open the 'Action' menu.
4. Select 'Export Configuration...'
5. Select a location and filename for the export.
6. Press Save.

This will export all your settings including all your templates and licensing data.

## Upgrading

Upgrading can be achieved by following the steps above to uninstall the current version and then install the new version. You may optionally stop the Microsoft Exchange Transport service once Exclaimer Mail Disclaimers has been uninstalled to prevent message delivery without having a disclaimer being applied. The installation of a new version of Exclaimer Mail Disclaimers will start the Microsoft Exchange Transport service.

## Fixed Issues

- Policy evaluation resulting in "no policies applied" in certain scenarios.
- Unable to select child containers due to a re-occurring parent container.

## New Features

- Feature for uppercasing first letters in a field now provides the option to either force or ignore the feature when a word is all uppercased.
- Reply separator list now supports regular expressions to deal with dynamically generated reply separators such as those generated by Gmail and iOS devices.\*

\*Reply separators for Gmail and iOS devices will only be present on new installations. The new reply separators will need to be added manually when upgrading from a previous version. ## Known Issues

- Character sets on plain text messages are not changed to the character set specified in the Disclaimer Options.
